TERMS OF CONTRACT:

Total period of contract of teaching faculty is 03 years or till attaining 70 years of age, whichever is earlier The initial period of contract would be for 01 year, extendable every year up to a maximum of 03 years, subject to satisfactory performance. Barring unsatisfactory performance the incumbent would serve the initial first year of contract, independent of regular faculty joining during this period. However, the contract would be terminable on one month notice, on joining of regular faculty in the $2^{nd}/3^{rd}$ year of contract.

**Although these posts are reserved for SC/ST category, in case of non-availability of the candidates of appropriate category, candidates from other category can be considered for appointment on contractual basis for period of less than 45 days. The contract will be renewable with further advertisement in absence of reserved candidates.
