## **Feedback evaluation of Workshops and action taken on the basis of feedback obtained**

**Post feedback evaluation report** : Medical education workshop ' Faculty attended the workshop fulltime and learned about lesson plan , objectives , SLO , various teaching learning tools , assessment plan , blueprinting , communication skills and integration curriculum .

### **A) Action taken :**

- a ) Faculty have implemented short answer question in assesment , considered various formative assessment in the form of item and part completion .
- b) Department have implemented integration between theory and practical in the form of intra-departmental integration .
- c) Departments have also motivated students in latest innovative technologies like body painting or making of anatomical models.
- d) Department have also focussed on implementation of communication skills , various pshycomotor skills besides the cognitive domain .
- e) Preparing of model answer have also been practised in preclinical , paraclinical and clinical department .
- f) Inter-departmental integrated research among the MBBS students have been practised .

### **B) Research Methodology on Bioethics Workshop**

#### **Feedback outcome analysis**

- 1) Post workshop research have increased among faculties and MBBS students.
- 2) Interdepartmental integrated research among the MBBS students have been practised .
- 3) IEC and IRB has been active in permitting research from bioethics and research perspective .

### **C) Plenary session :**

Sessions like Paediatric glaucoma have not only been beneficial among the ophthalmologists , paediatrician , other health professionals but also among 4<sup>th</sup> MBBS and MD students , senior residents , demonstrators and other faculties since all plenaries have been by eminent professionals and have been valuable in clinical settings in this college .



#### D) Student workshop on Organ transplantation :

“ Multidisciplinary topics” by eminent speakers in this field of transplantation have not only opened the windows among faculty and students but also motivated some to go ahead with it . A few MBBS students came up with a idea of donating their own body parts as well as opening a desk for transplantation in this institute .

All the above workshops have provided not only fruitful results but also motivated the faculties and students to further explore field of medical education as well as research and bioethics .
